For God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son. God gave his Son so that whoever believes in him may not be lost, but have eternal life.

Welcome to the month of July kids! This week we are going to learn about sharing with others. Notice in our verse for today it says that God GAVE His Son Jesus Christ to the world to show His love. You see kids, when we love someone, we don't just tell them, we do something to show that we love them. Since God

gave and we are His children, it means we must share with others. This month make an effort to share what you have with those children that don't have. For example, toys, sweets, or games. More importantly, don't be afraid to share what you've learnt about our Lord Jesus.

1 John 3:18



John 6:9 (ICB)

Here is a boy with five loaves of barley bread and two little fish. But that is not enough for so many people.

One sunny day, the Lord Jesus was sitting by a lake teaching and healing thousands of people. Now after a long day, the Lord Jesus noticed the people were hungry. The disciples told the Lord there was not enough money to buy food for thousands of people. But one young boy, having seen the miracles the Lord had done, stood up and offered his packed lunch

of five loaves and two small fish. To the disciples it was not enough but to the Lord He thanked God for it. He then shared it out and to everyone's surprise there was more than enough to eat. What a miracle that is! When you share the little that you have, it can make a big difference to someone's life kids.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

Everything I give or share makes a big difference. Whatever I have, I can share it because in Christ I have plenty! I am overflowing like Milk and Honey. I never run out because God supplies all my needs, Amen.

John 6:9-14

**John 6:5 (ICB)**

Jesus looked up and saw a large crowd coming toward him. He said to Philip, "Where can we buy bread for all these people to eat?"

Sometimes it's very easy to be selfish. For example, when you go into the kitchen to get some water, do you first ask everyone else if they'd like some too or do you just go and get it for yourself? The Lord Jesus always thinks of others, and this is why He cared for the people's well-being. I want you to notice that the little

boy was the only one who was willing to share his lunch with thousands of people even though it was little. Not one adult stood up to offer something in faith. Kids, learn from this little boy and think what another person might need.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I have the same spirit as the Lord Jesus Christ and I think of what others need. Thank you, Holy Spirit, for helping to see what others might need and using me to share. I am a giver! Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

John 6:1-14

**Philippians 2:4 (ICB)**

Do not be interested only in your own life but be interested in the lives of others.

Kids when was the last time you shared something with another person? Our verse today is encouraging us to think of what could benefit others first before ourselves because this is the mind of Christ. Today, think of how you could put a smile on someone's face. For example, you could share the computer or T.V so that others get a chance to watch or play. Maybe you could

give your time to talk to that classmate at school that everyone ignores and get to know them. How about letting others through the door first? Let's practice putting others first today!

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I am considerate and I am interested in the lives of others. I celebrate everyone and always think of what could benefit another person. Thank you, Lord, for helping to share my time, toys, snacks, and knowledge of God with others. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

Philippians 2:3-4



1 Kings 17:13 (ICB)

Elijah said to her, Don't worry. Go home and cook your food as you have said. But first make a small loaf of bread from the flour you have. Bring it to me. Then cook something for yourself and your son.

There was a time when there was a drought in the land and God told prophet Elijah to go and stay with a widow in Zarephath. When he arrived, he asked the widow for some bread and water, but the widow told Elijah she had no bread to share because the

one loaf she had was the last one for her and her son. In our verse Elijah tells the widow to cook for him first because God was going to take care of everything. She did as he said and to her surprise there was plenty of food and it never ran out! Glory be to God!

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

As I put others first, I will never run out of anything. Just like the widow, I shall never lack in my life as I live in super abundance in Jesus' Name. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

1 Kings 17:2-16



Mark 12:43 (ICB)

Jesus called his followers to him. He said, "I tell you the truth. This poor widow gave only two small coins. But she really gave more than all those rich people."

God is not concerned about the amount you give but rather the heart you give with. In our verse the Lord Jesus was sitting in the Temple watching everyone give their offering after the service. He saw many rich people give lots of money but then He noticed a poor widow who gave two coins that weren't worth much. The Lord told His disciples that out of everyone she gave the most because she gave all she had whilst

the rich gave what they didn't need. It showed God she was willing to give everything she had to see the kingdom progress and she trusted God would take care of her.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

When I share or give I do it to win souls because I have the love of God. I give and share the very best to those who need it because I want them to know that God cares for them. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

Mark 12:41-44

**Luke 6:38 (ICB)**

Give, and you will receive. You will be given much. It will be poured into your hands—more than you can hold. You will be given so much that it will spill into your lap. The way you give to others is the way God will give to you.”

Kids I want you to notice that in all the stories we read this week, the people did not have a lot to share with others or to give to God, but God did wonders with all that they did give. If all you have is one penny and you have faith that God will do something

and take care of you, He will do just that as we saw in our stories. Whatever little that you have, God can do something with it if you will only believe. When you give Him everything you have and are generous to share with others, trust in Him, that He will take care of all your needs, and you will never lack!

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

Kings shall come to me and hear wisdom from my mouth. In Christ, I have the solutions the world is looking for. My mouth speaks supernatural wisdom today! Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

2 Corinthians 9:7-8, Luke 6:38

**Psalm 46:1 (ICB)**

God is our protection and our strength. He always helps in times of trouble.

This week we are going to learn from the Holy Spirit how to help others but first we need to know that the Holy Spirit is our Helper. You see, as our verse says, the Holy Spirit always helps us in times of trouble. He does not just stand and watch you, the moment you ask for His help He jumps into action. He reminds you of God's Word, tells you what to do and strengthens you when you

are weak. He doesn't just help us sometimes but ALWAYS. So, whether it's trouble at school, stuck in a test or don't know what to wear remember to ask Him for His help today.

John 14:26



Luke 10:33 (ICB)

Then a Samaritan traveling down the road came to where the hurt man was lying. He saw the man and felt very sorry for him.

The Lord Jesus told a story of a man who was walking on a road and some robbers attacked him, tearing his clothes and beating him up. They abandoned him on the road and he was almost dead. Everyone who passed by ignored him and didn't help him. They all minded their own business. Then a Samaritan noticed the man was

in trouble and immediately helped him. He put bandages on his wounds and paid for a place for him to rest. Today, if you see someone needs help with something, don't ignore them but immediately get into action like the good Samaritan.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

By the Holy Spirit I love others as much I love myself and I do for others what I would like them to do for me. I will not ignore a person who needs my help, and I will act promptly. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

Luke 10:25-37



Galatians 6:2 (ICB)

Help each other with your troubles. When you do this, you truly obey the law of Christ.

Kids when we see someone in trouble, we must be quick to help them, just like our story of the Good Samaritan. Does your sibling need help to do their chores or homework? Does your mum or dad need some help carrying some groceries? Or maybe someone at school is struggling with some spellings or math and you could help? You never need to wait to ask if someone needs help, simply offer to help them.

Maybe there is a brother or sister in church who is upset and needs some encouragement, simply offer to pray with them and share the Word of God. When you do these things, you are truly being like Christ. Look for an opportunity to help someone today.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I prophesy that I will never be like those that ignored the injured man in the story of the Good Samaritan. I will be quick to help others because I am the superman in Christ! Amen.

Luke 10:25-37



Luke 5:5 (ICB)

Simon answered, "Master, we worked hard all night trying to catch fish, but we caught nothing. But you say to put the nets in the water; so, I will."

There was a time Peter and the other fishermen had worked all day and all night searching for fish and they had caught nothing. They were in trouble because they needed fish to make money and feed their families. When the Lord Jesus saw their troubled faces, He told them to go to deeper water and they would

find fish. Peter was sceptical but did as the Lord said and to his surprise, they had the biggest catch of their lives! They caught so many fish the nets began to break. Kids, the same Lord Jesus is in you and so if anyone has lost something, with you they will surely find it.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

Nothing can ever be lost with me because the Lord Jesus in me is the Way. I refuse any confusion in my life, and I prophesy that all that is lost shall be found in Jesus' Name.

FURTHER STUDY

Luke 5:1-9

**Luke 5:4 (ICB)**

When Jesus had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Take the boat into deep water. If you put your nets in the water, you will catch some fish."

Have you ever been stuck whilst doing your work? It's very frustrating and discouraging, isn't it? However, when someone comes to show you how to do it you feel relieved. You start saying, "I get it now!". This is exactly how Peter felt when he finally caught some fish after the Lord helped them. Now kids when was the last time you showed someone how to do

something? Do you ignore your siblings when they are stuck on a math sum? Do you show someone how to play a game or do you continue to just play it yourself. Remember that you are the light of the world and people need you to share your light by teaching them things that you know.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I am the light of the world, and many shall come to seek wisdom from me. I will share the Word of God with others and share my knowledge on subjects they are stuck on. Thank you Lord for your wisdom. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

1 Kings 4:34



1 Thessalonians 5:11 (ICB)
So, comfort each other and give each other strength, just as you are doing now.

Have you ever seen someone in class being shouted at by the teacher? Or have you seen someone crying because they are having a bad day? When you see someone whether in Church, School or at home who is down, ask the Holy Spirit to help you to comfort them. Comfort them by sharing the Word of God to encourage them. When you encourage someone and cheer them up it gives them strength. So,

helping others is not just by doing something but by saying something nice too. Today, put a smile on someone's face and compliment them.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I only speak Good News and my words are used to build others up and not to bring them down. My words refresh others and always leaves them feeling better. Thank you, Holy Spirit, for helping me to comfort others. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

1 Thessalonians 4:18

**Romans 12:10 (ICB)**

What a week it has been kids! We've learnt a lot about helping others and our final verse for the week reminds us to love and respect each other just as we do to ourselves. What does this mean? It means do things for others the way you would like them done to you. So, if you like it when people share with you, make sure to share with others. If you like it when people help you when you

are stuck or in trouble, do the same for others. If you want your siblings or others to be more helpful, start by being the most helpful person and they will learn from you as you are the light!

Galatians 5:13



1 Samuel 17:34-35 (ICB)

But David said to Saul, "I, your servant, have been keeping my father's sheep. When a lion or bear came and took a sheep from the flock, I would chase it..."

David was a young shepherd boy who looked after his father's many sheep. It was a big responsibility and although David was young, he took it very seriously. In our verse we can see that he didn't abandon the sheep when a beast came to take the sheep, he chased it away. He made sure his father found the sheep in the

same way he left them, and God loved this about David. Kids, when you are given responsibility by your parents take it seriously like David. If they give you money, toys or new clothes for example don't allow anything to be lost or broken. David didn't allow any bear to make a mess of his sheep and so you shouldn't allow your room to be messy.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I am responsible for all the Lord has given me. Like David, I refuse carelessness in my life now. Nothing of mine shall be lost or broken in Jesus' Name.

1 Samuel 17:17 (ICB)

Now Jesse said to his son David, "Take this half bushel of cooked grain. And take ten loaves of bread. Take them to your brothers in the camp."

David had seven siblings and he was the youngest. That's a big family! Now we usually think that older siblings are the ones to check on their younger ones. Whilst this is true, David cared for his big brothers. One day his father sent him to give lunch to his older brothers and check if they were well in the battlefield.

David gladly did as his father instructed him. I know most of us would have said, "They are older they should get their own food!" But not David. Just because you are the youngest or smallest it doesn't mean you can't check on your older siblings, cousins or brothers and sisters in Christ and encourage them.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I am my brothers and sisters' keeper. From now on I will check on my older siblings and obey my parent's instruction. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

1 Samuel 17:17-19



1 Samuel 16:7 (ICB)

But the Lord said to Samuel, "Don't look at how handsome Eliab is. Don't look at how tall he is. I have not chosen him. God does not see the same way people see. People look at the outside of a person, but the Lord looks at the heart."

When we stand with other big kids or adults, we think they are much bigger, stronger, smarter, prettier, or more handsome than we are and so God would never choose us. This is not true because when God told Samuel to anoint the next king of Israel

amongst David's brothers He chose David, the youngest and the smallest because of his good heart that loved God. Whilst people may judge you based on what you look like or how smart you are, God only sees your heart that loves Him.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I am chosen for such a time as this. Chosen, Favoured and Highly Blessed for Great things! I shall never be intimidated, and I shall walk tall knowing I am chosen by God. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

1 Samuel 16:4-13



1 Samuel 17:45 (ICB)

But David said to him, "You come to me using a sword, a large spear, and a small spear. But I come to you in the name of the Lord of heaven's armies. He's the God of the armies of Israel! You have spoken out against him."

The armies of Israel were facing the Philistines and David's brothers were there. However, they were terrified of the Philistine giant called Goliath and they didn't know what to do. David was not afraid because he trusted God and not in his own ability. You

see whilst Goliath was a giant with giant weapons, David was small and had nothing, but a sling shot and his faith in God. With just one shot, David killed Goliath and the Philistines fled. Kids it doesn't matter how big the challenge is, always be like David and trust God to help you. You will always win.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

It is not by power nor by my own strength but by the Holy Spirit I will succeed in all I put my hand. No challenge is too big for me. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

1 Samuel 17:25- 52



1 Samuel 24:6 (ICB)

He said to his men, "May the Lord keep me from doing such a thing to my master! Saul is the Lord's appointed king. I should not do anything against him, because he is the Lord's appointed king!"

Having defeated Goliath, David was loved by all the citizens but this made King Saul jealous and so he decided to kill David. After a long day of chasing David with his army, the king decided to rest in a nearby cave, but he didn't know that David and his men were hidden deeper in the cave.

David's friends encouraged him to attack the king because of all the wrong he had done to him, but he refused. David knew even though the king was trying to kill him, God had put him in authority. Kids, when we get scolded for something we didn't do be like David. Always love, respect, and pray for those around you.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

Lord Holy Spirit, help me to respect all those who are above me. Help me to love them and pray for them in Jesus' Name. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

1 Samuel 24:1-17

**James 4:4 (ICB)**

So, you people are not loyal to God! You should know that loving the world is the same as hating God. So, if a person wants to be a friend of the world, he makes himself God's enemy.

When David finally became king, he remembered to move God's Ark to a special location as God told him. Every citizen was joyous because David was king. Have you ever been popular or know someone that is popular? Well in all his excitement, David forgot the one rule God gave him as they moved the Ark; it was that nobody should touch it. So, as they moved the Ark a man named Uzzah tried to prevent it from falling and

touched it. He instantly died! Everyone was shocked. David was sorry and remembered the rule and followed it. Kids, listening to God is more important than being liked by everyone.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

Thank you, Lord, for giving me an obedient heart that listens to God all the time. It doesn't matter what happens, I will only listen to what God's Word says. Amen.

2 Samuel 6:1-9

**1 Samuel 13:14 (ICB)**

...The Lord has looked for the kind of man he wants. The Lord has appointed him to become ruler of his people. He is doing this because you haven't obeyed his command."

What a week we've had with David! From a shepherd boy to king, David's life was full of ups and downs. You see from the very beginning God told prophet Samuel to tell the king Saul that he was going to be replaced by David; the kind of man he wants. What was it about David that the Lord

loved? It was that he listened to God and trusted Him every day. He also cared about God's kingdom deeply. King Saul had started listening to his friends instead of God. Be like David; listen to God, trust Him, and focus on His kingdom.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I am the kind of person God wants because I love what God loves and hate what God hates. Everything I do is to advance God's kingdom and win more souls. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

Matthew 6:33



Ephesians 5:20 (ICB)

Always give thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

How does it feel when you do something for someone, and they don't say thank you? It's not a nice feeling and in fact you may never want to help that person again because they are ungrateful. Well, you'd be surprised at how many of God's children can go an entire day without saying thank you to God. Our verse tells us we must thank God ALWAYS and not when we feel like it because every day God makes sure

there is something to be thankful for. Today look for every chance to say thank you to God.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

Thank you, Lord, for this day and all You have prepared for me. Open my eyes to see what I can thank you for. Thank you for my health, protection, food, and family. Thank you for my nice clothes and toys. Thank you for my church family. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

1 Chronicles 16:34

**Acts 16:25 (ICB)**

About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing songs to God. The other prisoners were listening to them.

Let's remind ourselves of the power of being thankful to God by remembering Paul and Silas. Paul and Silas were badly beaten and put in jail with other common criminals, yet they were innocent. Instead of complaining to God, they worshipped Him and thanked Him for being alive and that He loved them. They remembered all the good things that God had done. As they continued, suddenly ALL the

jail cells for every prisoner were opened by God. They were free! Even though it seems it's a bad day, find something to be thankful for and God will change your day!

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I'm changing the way I think. I will not only thank You Lord when things are good, but I will thank you when things are bad! I am full of praises in season and out of season. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

Acts 16:16-40



Acts 27:35-36 (ICB)

After he said this, Paul took some bread and thanked God for it before all of them. He broke off a piece and began eating. All the men felt better...

There was another time Paul was a prisoner and was on a ship full of prisoners headed to Italy. On their way a mighty storm hit the ship and blew it off its path. They were lost and everyone on the ship was afraid they would drown. The ship floated on the sea for fourteen days and none of the soldiers had eaten. Paul encouraged everyone to eat, and

our verse tells us that as soon as he thanked God the men felt better and began to eat. A few hours later they found land. Kids, when you are surrounded by people who are fearful, calm them down by giving God thanks and see His wonders.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

Ten thousand tongues wouldn't be enough to thank You Lord for Your goodness in every situation. No matter how bad a day looks, You are there to make it better Hallelujah! Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

Acts 27:7-44

**Luke 17:18 (ICB)**

Is this Samaritan the only one who came back to thank God?

One day as the Lord was traveling, he met ten men with leprosy and all of them shouted for his help. The Lord instructed them to go and show themselves to the priest. Now as they were on their way the men realised, they were all healed! But only one of them went back to thank the Lord Jesus. The Lord was shocked at how ungrateful the other nine men were and so He blessed the one who said thank you. When God

does something for you, be quick to thank the Lord before you tell anyone. Being thankful shows Him you have faith! Don't allow the Lord Jesus to be shocked you didn't say thank you like those other nine men.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

I will not forget all the Lord has done for me and my family. I have a grateful heart that sees the Lord's work in everything concerning me. Thank you my Lord. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

Luke 17:11-18

**Mark 6:41 (ICB)**

Jesus took the five loaves and two fish. He looked up to heaven and thanked God for the bread. He divided the bread and gave it to his followers for them to give to the people. Then he divided the two fish among them all.

There was a time when the Lord Jesus was teaching over five thousand people by a lake, and He noticed that they were hungry after a long day. When He asked the disciples where they could get food for the people, they told Him it was impossible to

get food for so many. As they spoke, a young boy offered his packed lunch of five loaves and two fish to the Lord and the Lord thanked God for it. Immediately He shared out the food and all they people ate as much as they wanted. From such a small lunch, thousands ate because the Lord thanked God.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

With whatever little I have; in the hands of God, it can do mighty things. Whether I have little or plenty I shall thank God for His supply. Amen.

FURTHER STUDY

Mark 6:34-44



1 Thessalonians 5:18 (ICB)
Give thanks whatever happens.
That is what God wants for you
in Christ Jesus.

One thing we can learn this week is that whether we have plenty or little or whether things are bad or good we should always thank and praise the Lord for all that He has done for us. Would you rather hang out with someone who is always complaining about what they don't have and keeps asking you for things or would you rather have someone who appreciates you and compliments you? I know who I'd rather

be with! It's the same with God. Being thankful shows that you recognize and notice God's work and this will cause Him to keep doing more and more. Today, God will never get tired of hearing you say thank you to Him.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

Philippians 4:6



Psalm 103:2 (ICB)

**My whole being, praise the Lord.
Do not forget all his kindnesses.**

What a week of being thankful. Remember that it's something you should continue to do all your life, not occasionally. Now sometimes when we are in trouble and are about to pray, we forget to start by remembering God's kindness. Today, I want you to learn how to take time before you ask God for what you want, to thank Him for who He is. Our verse says do not forget because it's very easy to forget how loving and kind our God is. From now on start your

prayers by thanking Him for forgiving all your wrongdoings, how he has healed you and keeps you healthy and how He has loved you.

Each one should give, then, what he has decided in his heart to give. He should not give if it makes him sad. And he should not give if he thinks he is forced to give. God loves the person who gives happily.

God loved us so much that He gave us His only Son Jesus Christ. When we received our new life in Christ we are born to be givers, and we have the mind and heart of Christ in us. Practice living as a giver and someone who constantly shares. The more you do it the easier it becomes. Start by telling yourself

in the mirror every day that I am a cheerful giver. Giving is easy for me and sharing with others is natural to me because I am born of God. Don't stop saying it and practice it.

I am the biggest giver because I have the biggest heart. I share with others constantly as I have the love of God in me. Amen.

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

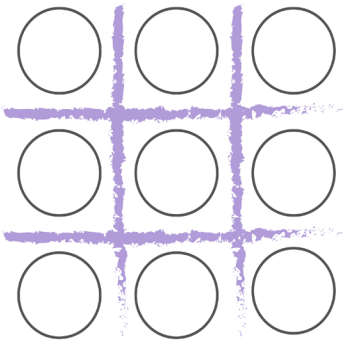
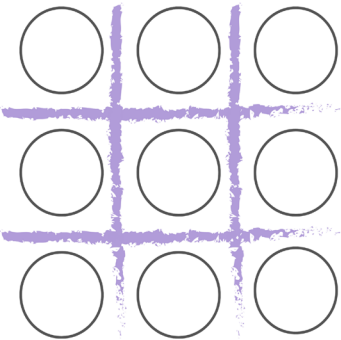
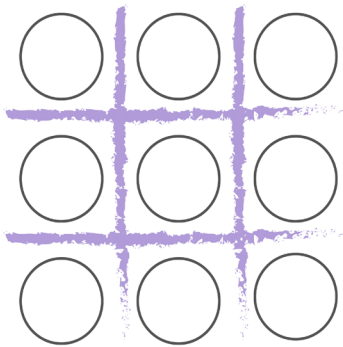
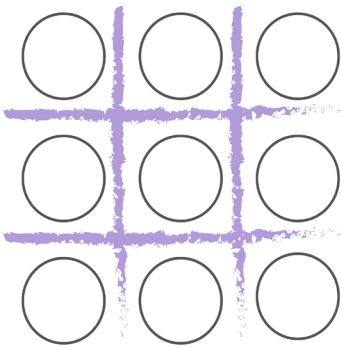

It was the land flowing with milk and honey and the LORD had told the children of Israel that He had given them the land to inhabit. Caleb returned convinced that the Israelites were able to take the land. The people, however, did not believe.

Caleb believed God and arose in faith and courage to take the Canaanite land that the LORD had already given them. What God had said was enough for Caleb to step out in faith to conquer the land. Numbers 13:33 (ICB)

We saw the Nephilim people there. (The Anakites come from the Nephilim people.) We felt like grasshoppers. And we looked like grasshoppers to them."

Listen to the report of most of the spies who were sent to check out the land of Canaan. They said that they felt like grasshoppers. Not only that, but they looked like grasshoppers to the giants there. How did the spies know what they looked like to the giants? Did they ask them? No! As a man thinks in his heart, so is he.

Kids, whatever you believe is real to you. This is because you believe it. Your life will not go beyond what you believe. Do not look at your own abilities, skills, or strengths. Depend on the LORD's ability to overcome any obstacle standing in your way. Take the land, you can do it!

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

 The entrance of your words gives light; it gives understanding to the simple.

When you watch a football match on TV or if you happen to watch it in the stadium, you will notice how bright the lights are. This is the kind of light that enters you when you read and understand the Bible. The Psalmist here said that the entrance of God's words gives light. It gives understanding to someone who may not have understood things on his own.

Kids, as you read and understand the Bible, light is entering you. The light that is entering you is Photizo light (stadium) light. This type of light cannot be hidden. Today, know that you are a city that is set on a hill, amen!
