PRAYER FOR YOU

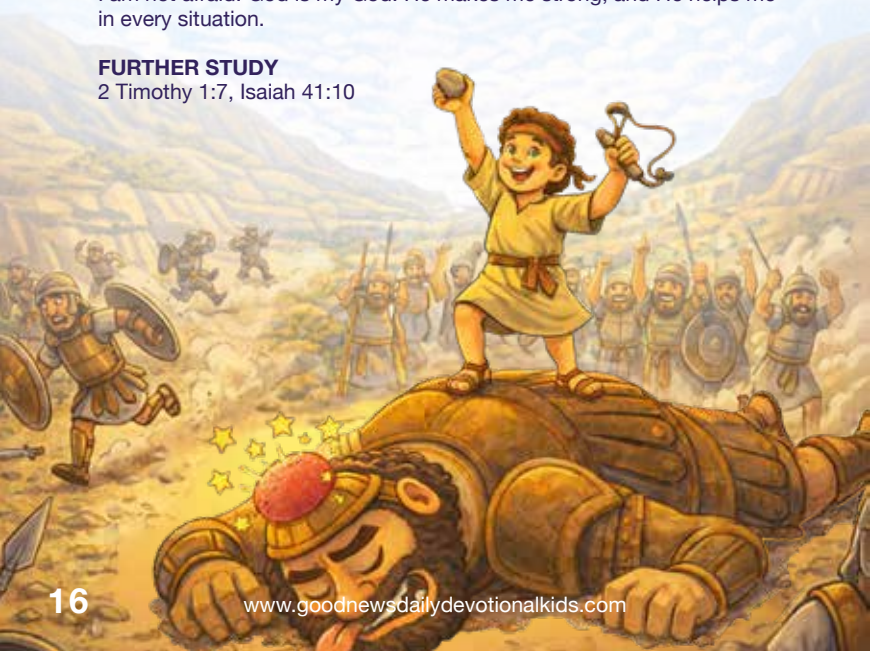
Dear God, thank You for being with me and in me wherever I go. Fear is not in my vocabulary because You are my God! Amen.

PRAYER FOR YOU

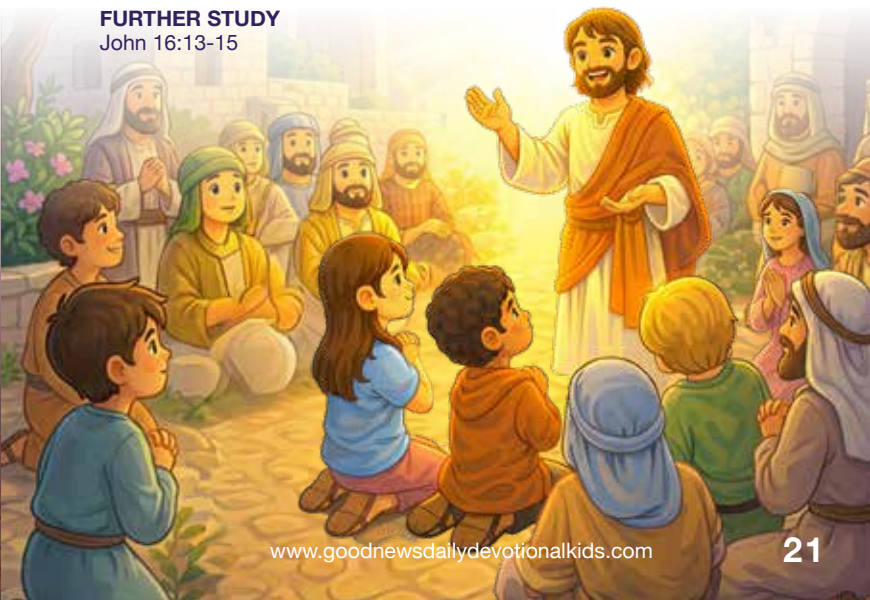
Dear God, thank You for the gift of the Holy Spirit. He lives in me and will guide me into all truth. Amen.

PRAYER FOR YOU

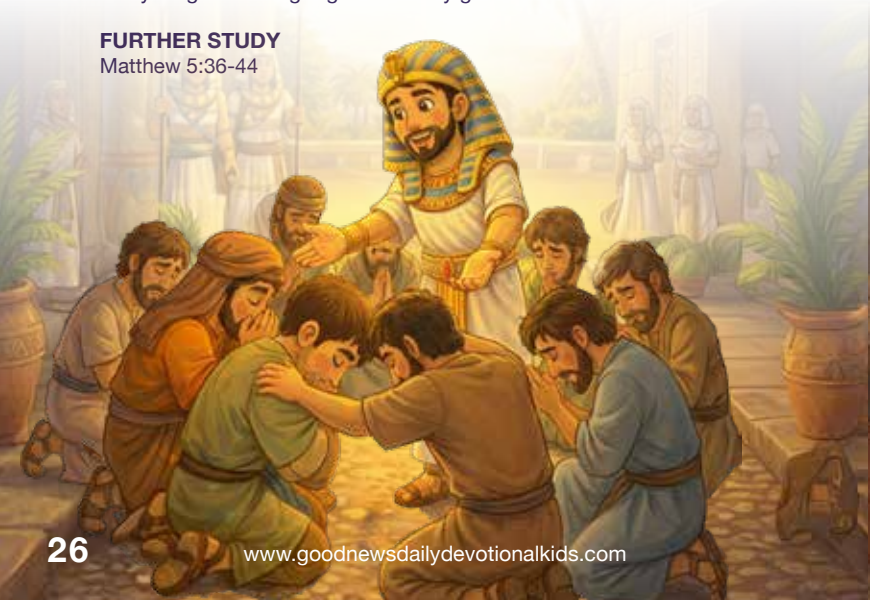
Dear God, thank You for helping me to forgive others when they do me wrong. I show Your Nature when I forgive. Amen.

PRAYER FOR YOU

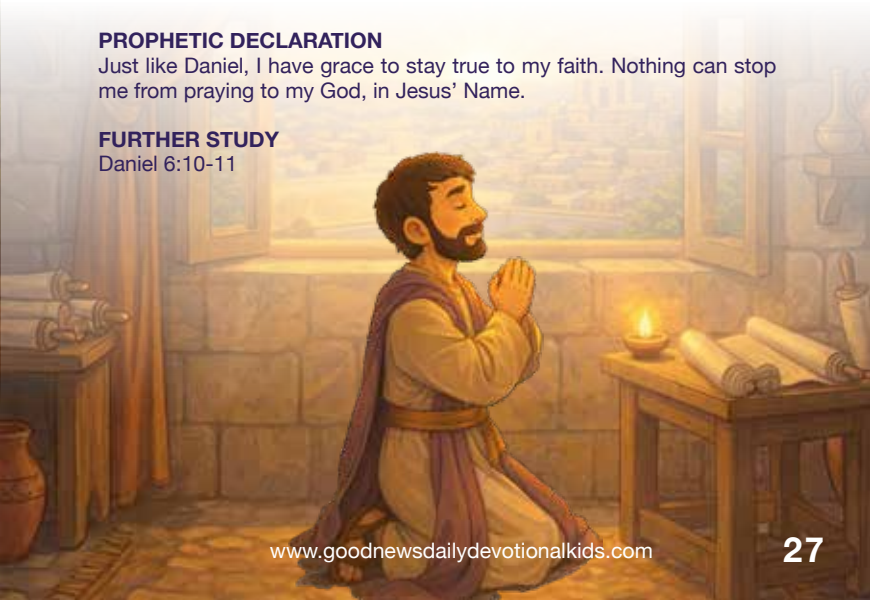
Dear God, thank You for helping me to stay true to my faith, just like Daniel. In times of trouble, he remained faithful. Help me to stay faithful too. Amen.

PRAYER FOR YOU

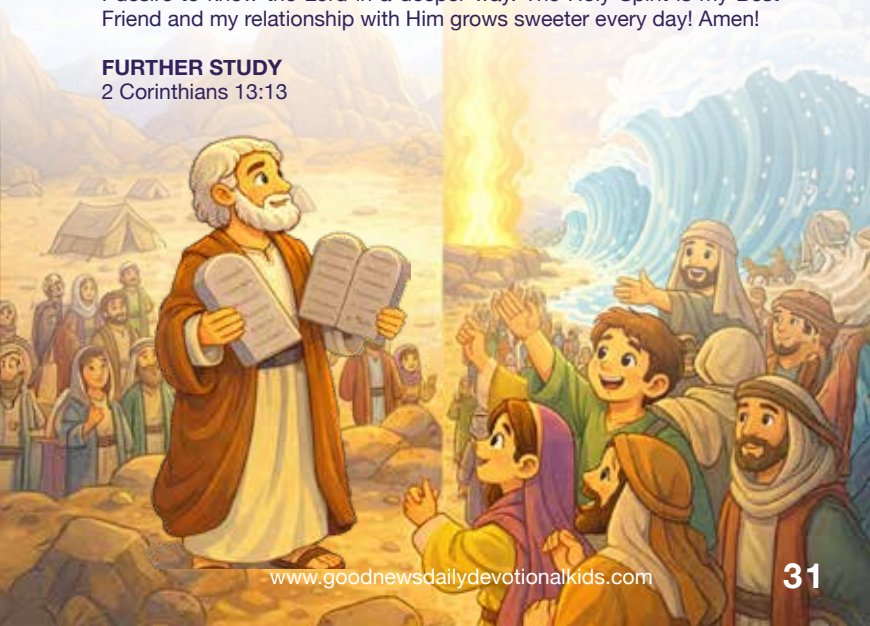

PRAYER FOR YOU

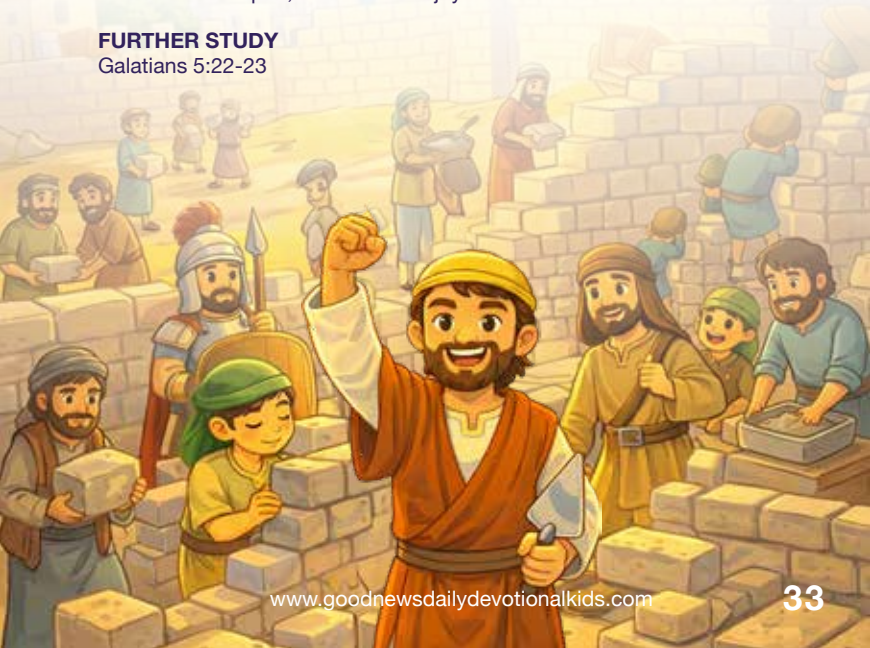

PRAYER FOR YOU

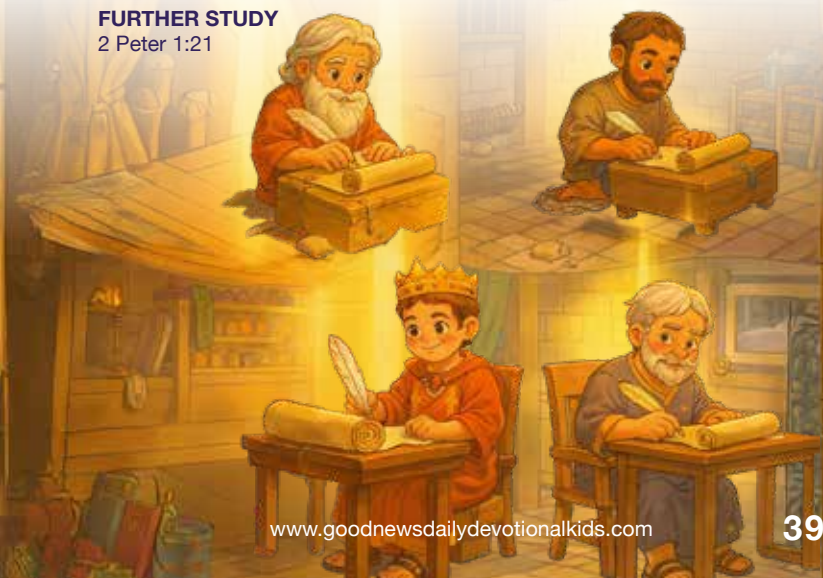
Holy Spirit, thank You for writing the Bible. Help me love Your Word, understand it, and obey it daily. Amen.

PRAYER FOR YOU

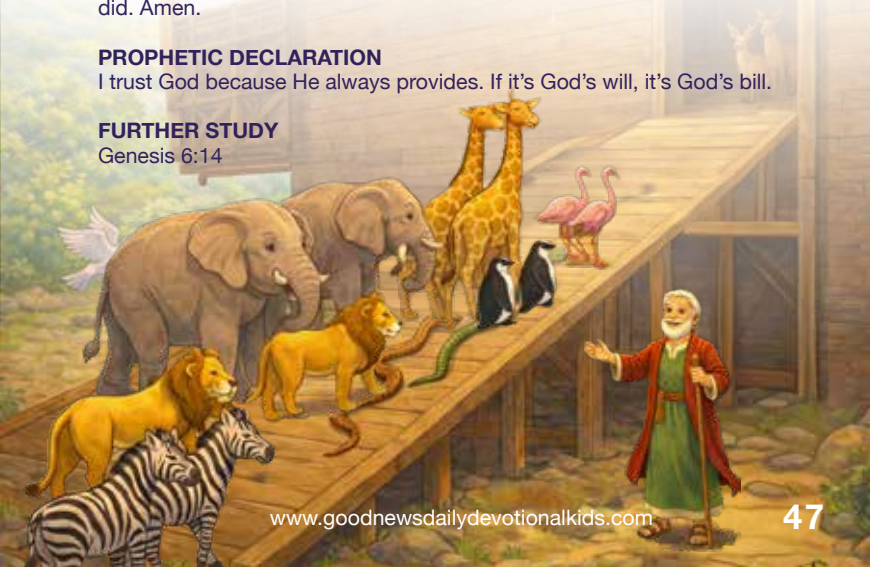
Father, thank You for always providing. Help me trust you just like Noah did. Amen.

Have you ever been feeling like, “I studied very hard” or in sport, “I have trained so hard,” and then the results say something you were not expecting? These things happen, whether in school or at home.

Don't let little things ruin your day. Sometimes things may not seem fair, but when you feel upset about them, remind yourself of what God's Word says. Don't give anyone power over your joy. Instead, remember: “I know I didn't get the results I wanted, but I know everything works for my own good.” When you do that, you show confidence in God, and that allows Him to change the whole situation into something beautiful. Remember, God is always on your side.

PRAYER FOR YOU

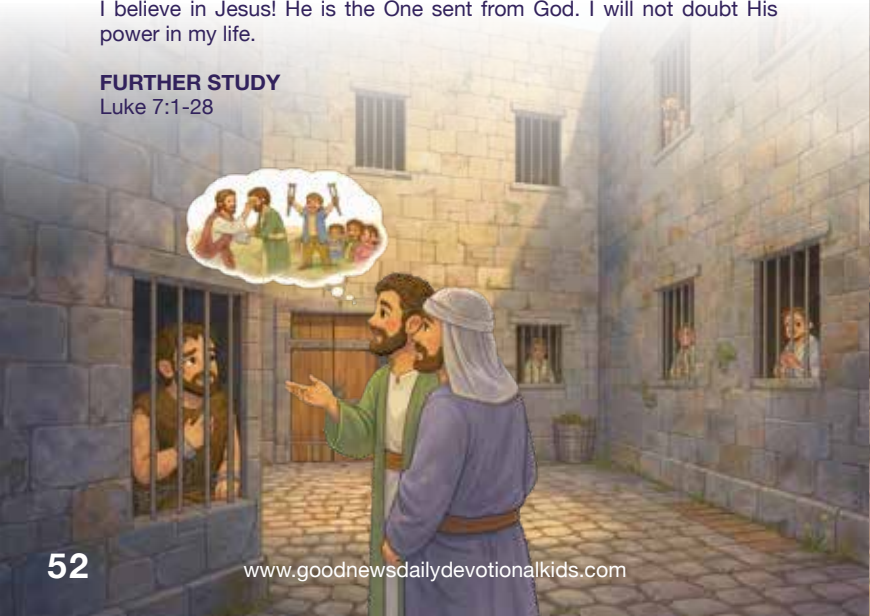

PRAYER FOR YOU

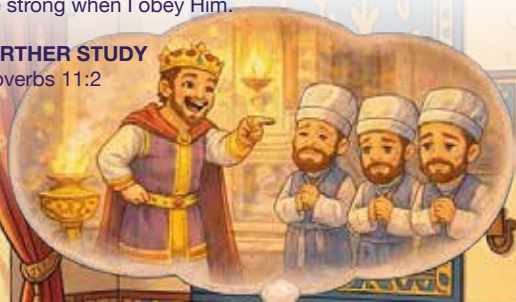

PRAYER FOR YOU

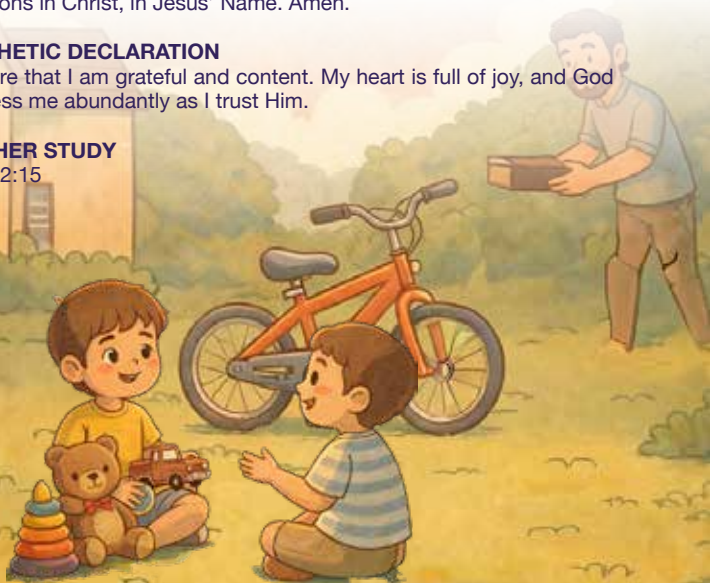

PRAYER FOR YOU

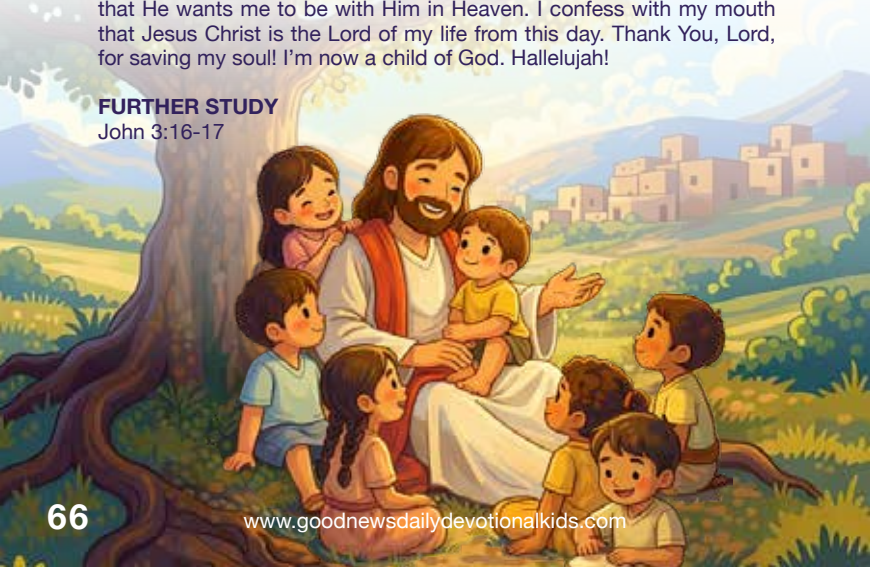

PRAYER FOR YOU

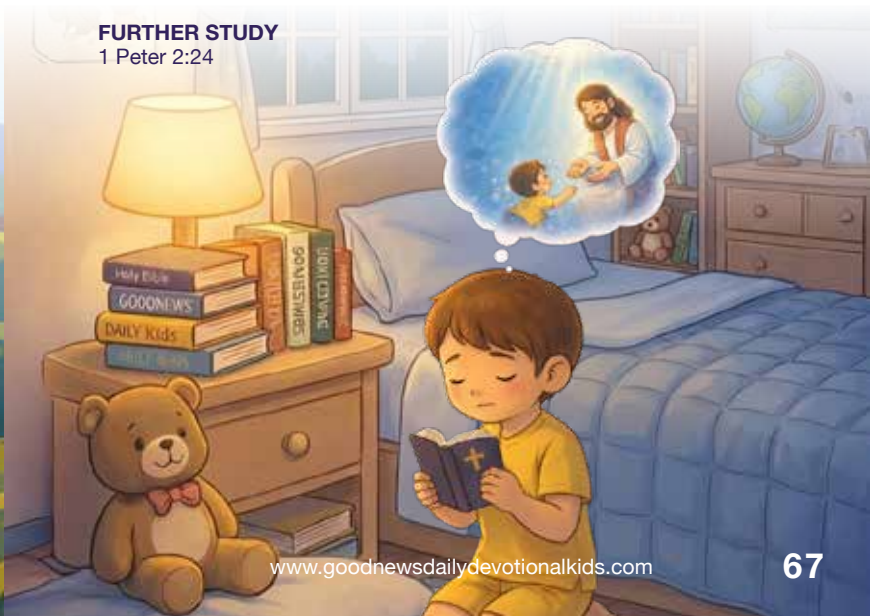
Lord, help me to go deeper in prayer, worship, and Your Word so that I can know You more and shine for You. Amen.

PRAYER FOR YOU

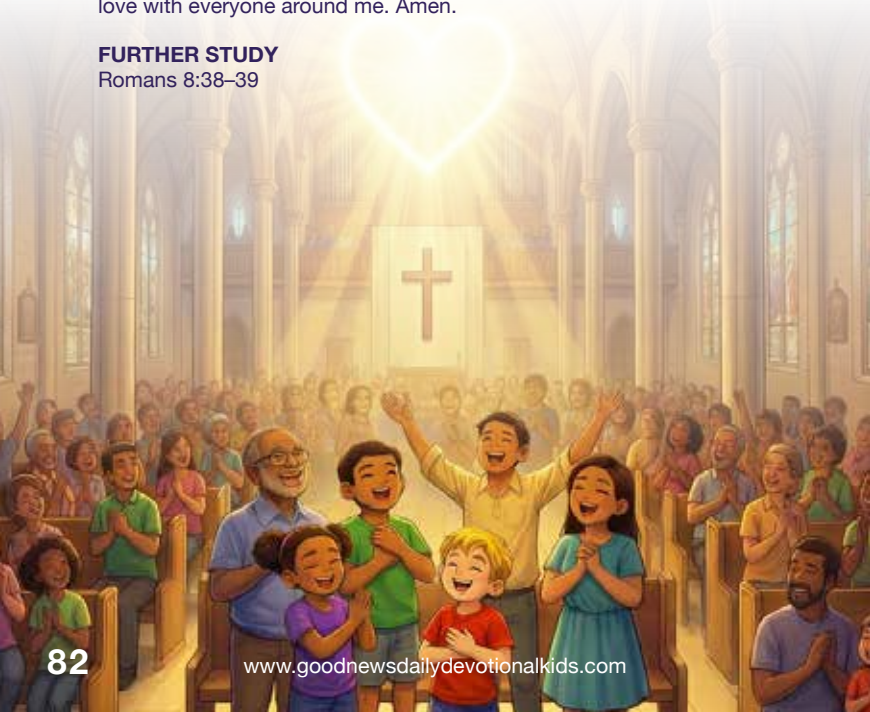
Father, thank You for loving me forever. Help me to share that same love with others. Amen.

PRAYER FOR YOU

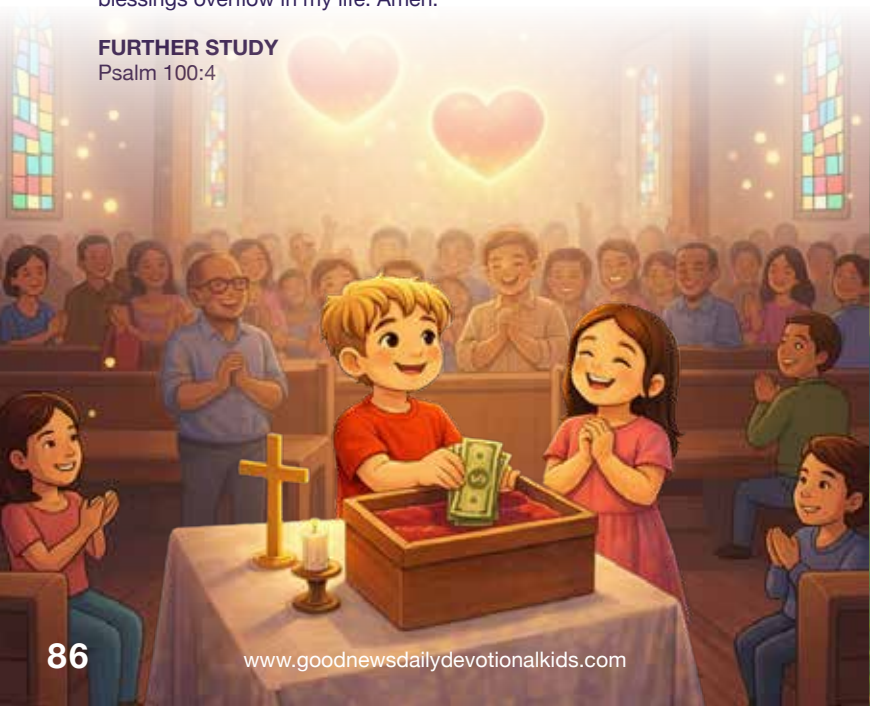
Father, I am thankful for all You have given me. Help me to always praise You with joy. Amen.

PRAYER FOR YOU

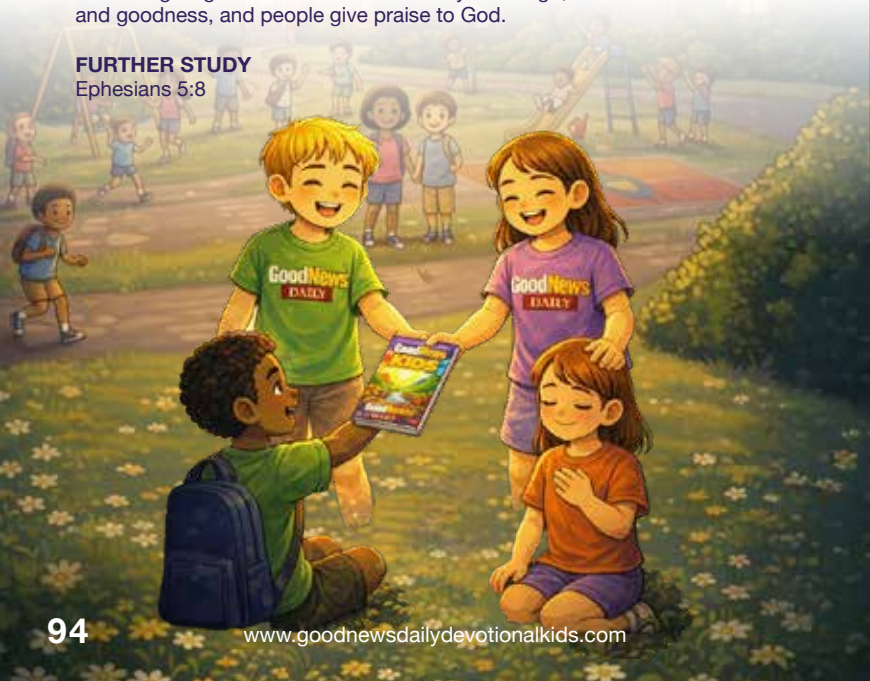
