Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

In the chemistry lab, you've probably seen how invisible forces at the molecular level come together to make something totally new and visible. For example, invisible to our naked eyes are the molecules of hydrogen and oxygen, yet through a chemical reaction they become a visible substance called water.

REDEEMING THE TIME

Ephesians 5:16 (KJV)

Redeeming the time, because the days are evil.

In this generation, our phones have become so ingrained in our lives that the average person reaches for their phone nearly 2,617 times every day! On average, people spend about 2 hours and 23 minutes on social media each day. These platforms are marketed as free, but they actually cost you your attention. Mobile phones have replaced conventional alarm clocks, so it is common to find people reaching for their phones as soon as they wake up.

Instead of reaching for your phone, reach for God. Take a moment to kneel and say your morning prayers and read the Word of God. Don't stop there: try to allocate six minutes each hour to pray throughout the day. It may seem challenging, but six minutes is not much more than the length of the average song! With this small change in your routine, you will bank a tenth of your day in prayer, and every hour will be covered!

If you don't have time for God, you will have no time!

RHINOCEROS FAITH

2 Corinthians 4:18 (KJV)

While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.

The rhinoceros is one of the most intelligent animals you can find. It can hear and figure out imaginatively another type of animal 30 kilometres away just by the sound that animal makes.

However, the rhinoceros has a sight problem, it cannot see beyond 20 metres. When the rhinoceros is consumed by danger and fear sets in, it records through the senses that it is useless to depend on its eyesight because it cannot see the imposing danger; so, it steadfastly resorts to its imaginative ability.

The rhinoceros charges blind towards the danger to knock it down. Apostle Paul tells us in 2 Corinthians 5:7 “For we walk by faith, not by sight”. When you are facing problems like stress, worry, etc have the attitude of the rhinoceros – charge and knock it down by faith!

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

Judges 6:12 (KJV)

And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him, and said unto him, The LORD is with thee, thou mighty man of valour.

God knows you more than you know yourself. The Bible says Gideon was hiding from the Philistines, who were coming every time to plunder and take the harvest from the Israelites. Gideon's hiding was a clear sign of fear and timidity, but God did not address him according to how Gideon felt or saw himself. Instead, God called him what He knew Gideon to be: a "mighty man of valour." Gideon must have wondered, How can God call me mighty, yet I'm hiding from the adversaries? The answer is that when God looks at you, He sees beyond what you see.

You might see yourself as just another student trying to get by through every year, but God sees you as a solution to many problems. So, don't allow your environment, background, or educational status to define you. You were born to conquer in the Name of Jesus!

HE'S KNOCKING AT THE DOOR OF YOUR HEART

Revelation 3:20 (KJV)

Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hears my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

One major lesson I'd like everyone to take away from this verse is that the Lord Jesus Christ is NOT knocking at the Church door: He's knocking on your heart. This verse can feel like a throwback to how real relationships work, especially in today's world.

Imagine someone important wanting to spend time with you. They're at your door, knocking, waiting for you to open up and hang out. The verse does not say if the Church will open its doors to the promptings of God; the call is to individuals.

Church membership or positions do not guarantee a relationship with God. So, the only way for the Church of God to get right is by each person reading this to get right. Remember that the Church is not a building; the church is YOU. He's knocking!

My heart is inditing a good matter and I open my heart for my Heavenly Father to reside. I am ready for a deeper relationship with Him from now. Hallelujah!

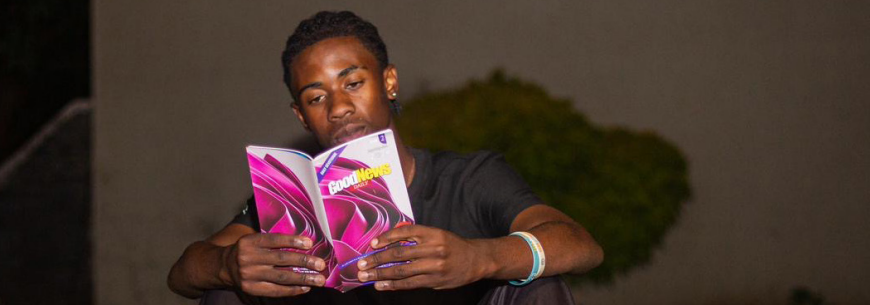

When you feel overwhelmed, remember Philippians 4:13: "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." God will give you the strength and peace you need to succeed!

HOW TO BUILD

A DAILY PRAYER HABIT

1: Set a Specific Time for Prayer

Psalm 55:17 - "Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I pray, and cry aloud: and he shall hear my voice."

Tip: Choose a time that works best for you, like right after waking up or before bed. Consistency is key.

2: Find a Quiet Place

Matthew 6:6 - "But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly."

Tip: Find a spot where you can focus and not be distracted. It could be your room or a quiet corner.

3: Use a Prayer Plan or Journal

Psalm 141:2 - "Let my prayer be set forth before thee as incense; and the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice."

Tip: Write down what you want to pray about—like giving thanks, asking for guidance, and praying for others. This helps keep your prayers aligned to the will of God.

4: Start Small and Grow

1 Thessalonians 5:17 - "Pray without ceasing."

Tip: Begin with just a few minutes each day and gradually extend your prayer time as it becomes a natural part of your routine. Remember, it's about your heart's connection with God, not how long you pray.

With these steps, building a daily prayer habit becomes easier and more meaningful!

ISAIAH 54.

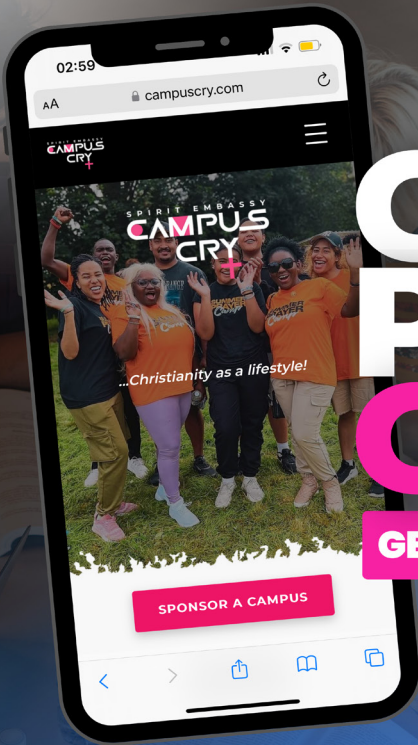
14 I am built solid, grounded in righteousness. Far from any trouble - nothing to fear! Far from terror- it won't even come close!
