

Fun facts about the Bible

How many of the following did you know kids?

- 1 There are 66 total books in the Bible and here is great way to remember it.
Remember the numbers 3 and 9
There are 39 books in the Old Testament.
Multiply 3×9 and the answer is 27
There are 27 Books in the New Testament.
If you add 39 and 27 and the answer is 66
There are 66 books in the entire Bible.
- 2 There are over 40 writers including scribes, fishermen, kings, royal officials, musicians, prophets, poets, farmers and others are believed to have contributed to the texts of the Bible.
- 3 With 40 authors, the Bible has been written on 3 continents.
Asia, Africa and Europe.
- 4 There are five types of book in the Holy Bible;
Historical, Poetry, Prophetic, Epistles and the Gospels.
- 5 There are around 2.3 billion followers of Christianity in the world - that is nearly a third of the world's population.
- 6 There were two men in the Bible that never died, they were Enoch (Genesis 5:21-24) and Elijah (2 Kings 2).
- 7 The Bible was written in Aramaic, Hebrew, and Greek.
The New Testament was written in Greek, the Old Testament mostly in Hebrew, and just a few chapters in Aramaic, which was the language of the more common Jewish people. Hebrew was mostly the language of scholars and religious leaders.
