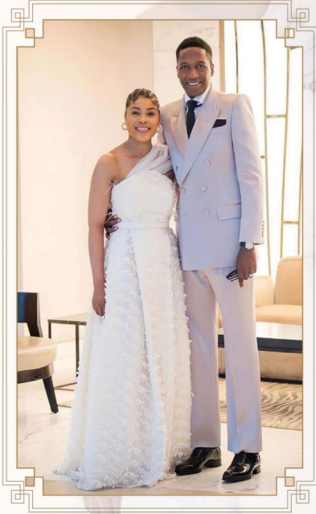

The Holy Spirit lives on the inside of me, I am full of goodness! I will shine my light wherever I go! Hallelujah. Amen.

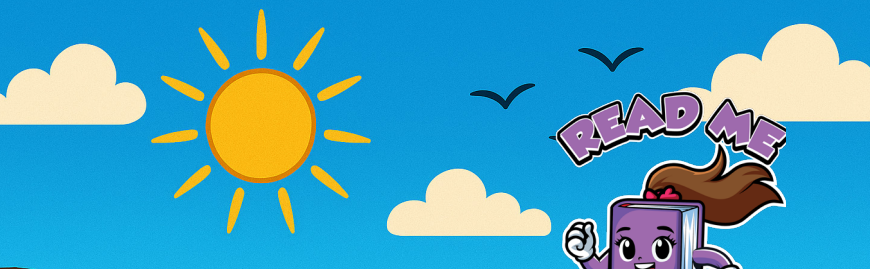

I will trust The Lord completely and not doubt His Word, I am walking into favour and grace.

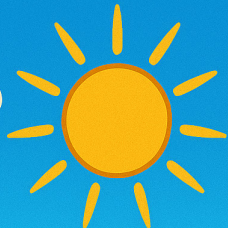
PRAYER FOR TODAY

I will be kind loving and united and put others first by showing them the love of Christ.

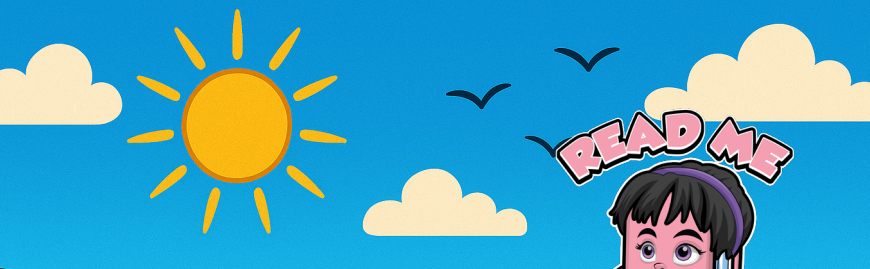

Thank you Lord for always being there for me and loving, guiding me and protecting me always.

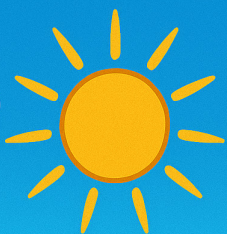
PRAYER FOR TODAY

I am a fearless messenger for Jesus. His Light shines through me, and I will tell others about His love. Hallelujah! Amen.

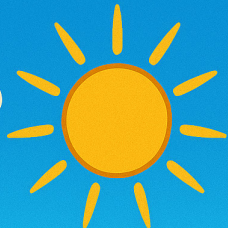

I trust You God to lead me on the most exciting adventures, and I'm ready to follow You anywhere.

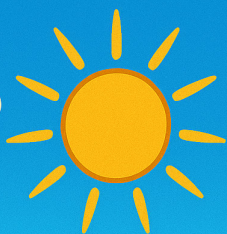

I will choose to follow Jesus Christ and also tell others about Him so that they can also experience the love of God.

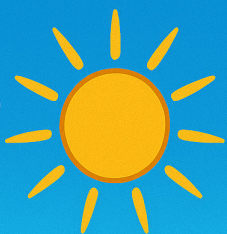

I am a child of God! He knows me by name, loves me, and I belong to His family forever.

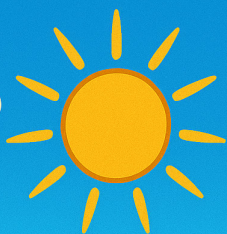

Jesus Christ is the superstar. I choose to point to Him in everything that I say and do.

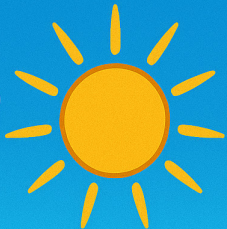

I will stand strong like Esther. Even if I feel afraid, I will choose to do what's right because God is with me.

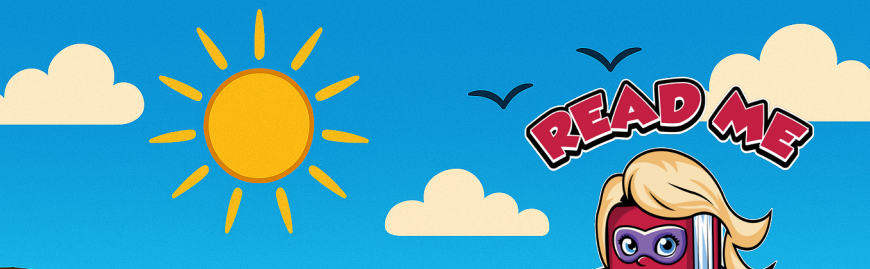

PROPHETIC DECLARATION

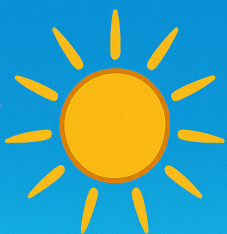
I will be brave like David. I know that You are with me Lord, and I can trust You always.

Thank you Lord for giving me the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, by Your Holy Spirit I can never be disadvantaged. Hallelujah.

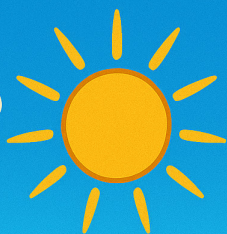

I love spending time with God and being in His House. It is a delight to serve the Lord, and I will carry out the work of God in my life. Amen.

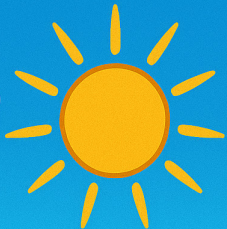

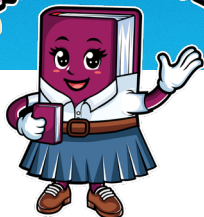

I am a child of God, and I will show His love and joy to the world! Hallelujah.

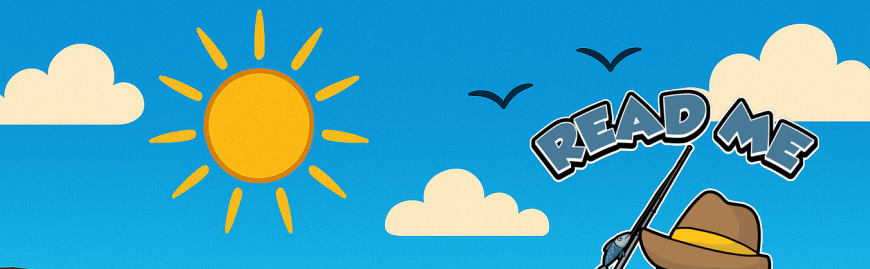

I am in control of my thoughts and feelings, and I choose to be joyful! I will always praise God for what He has done for me.

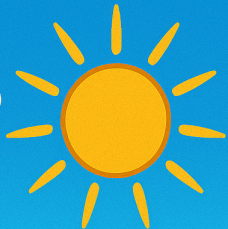

Thank you Lord for coming to find and save lost people like me. Help me to follow You every day and share Your love with others.

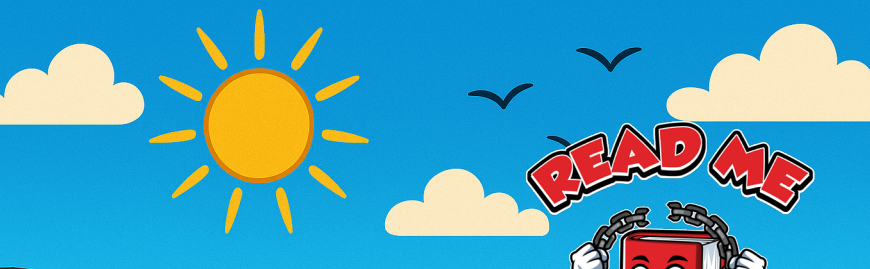

I will share the Good News with someone today because the love of Christ is worth sharing. Glory be to God.

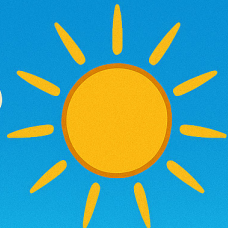

I will take responsibility for my actions and do everything without complaining or arguing, but instead with a grateful heart. Hallelujah.

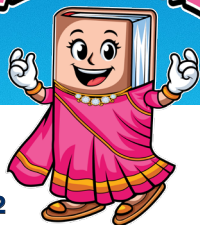
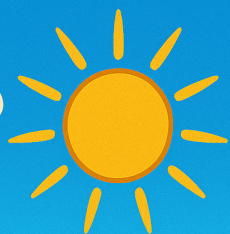

I will let my light shine so that others may see the good things I do and give God all the praise. Hallelujah.

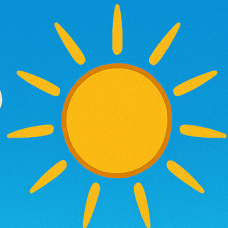

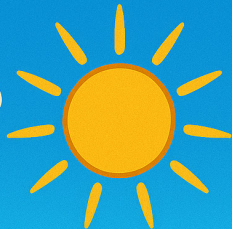

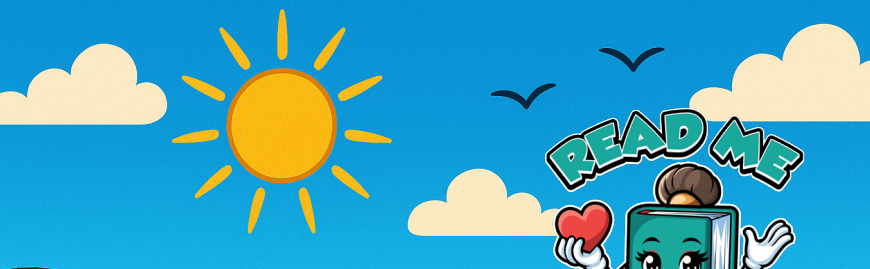

I am fearless! No matter what happens, I know God is always with me, and He will protect me, and I will always have faith in Him.

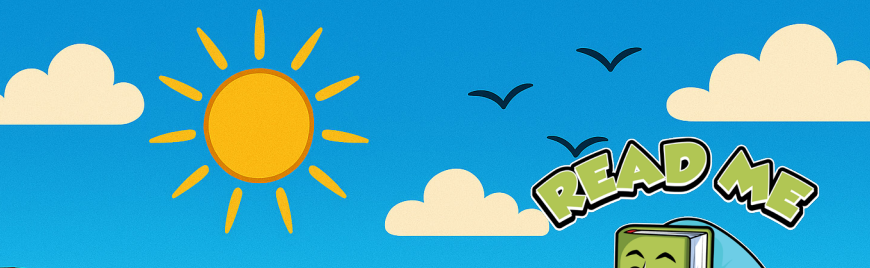

I trust God with all my heart. Even when things are hard, I believe He is with me, and I will stand strong in my faith no matter what.

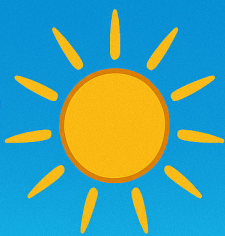

The Holy Spirit lives with me and in me. I am never alone because God's Spirit helps me know the truth and stay close to Him.

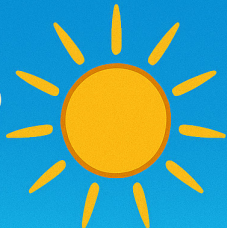

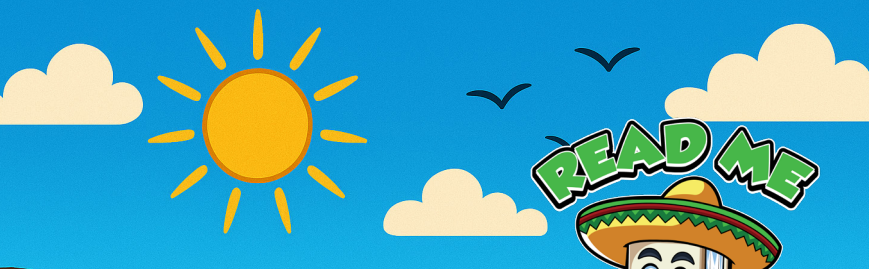

God’s promises for me are big and full of hope. Just like the stars in the sky, His blessings are too many to count, and I trust Him to do great things in my life.

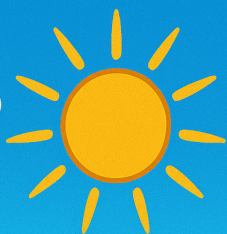
