PRAYER FOR YOU

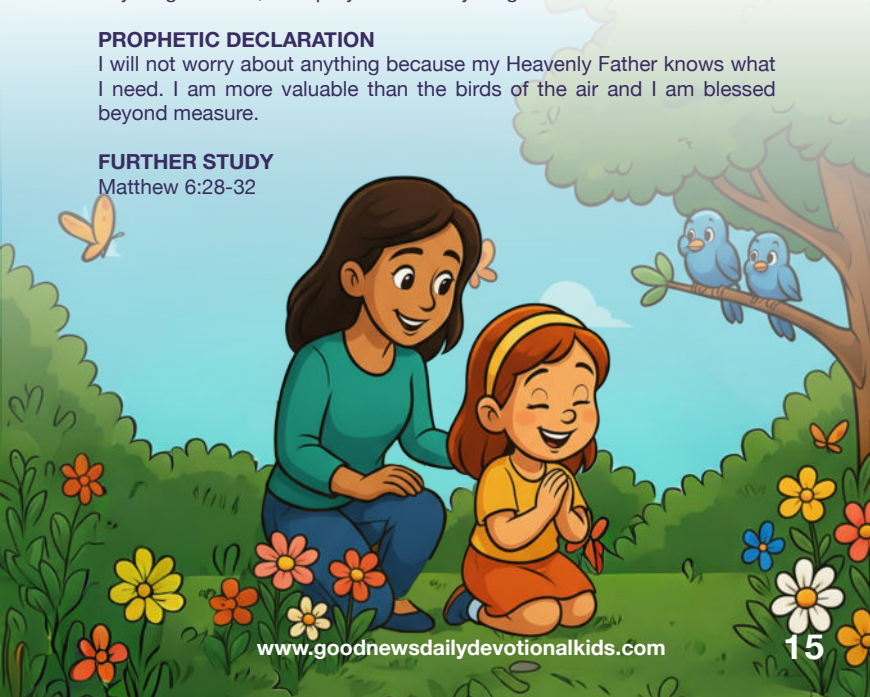
Dear God, You know exactly what I need. I do not have to worry about anything. Instead, I will pray about everything in Jesus Name. Amen.

PRAYER FOR YOU

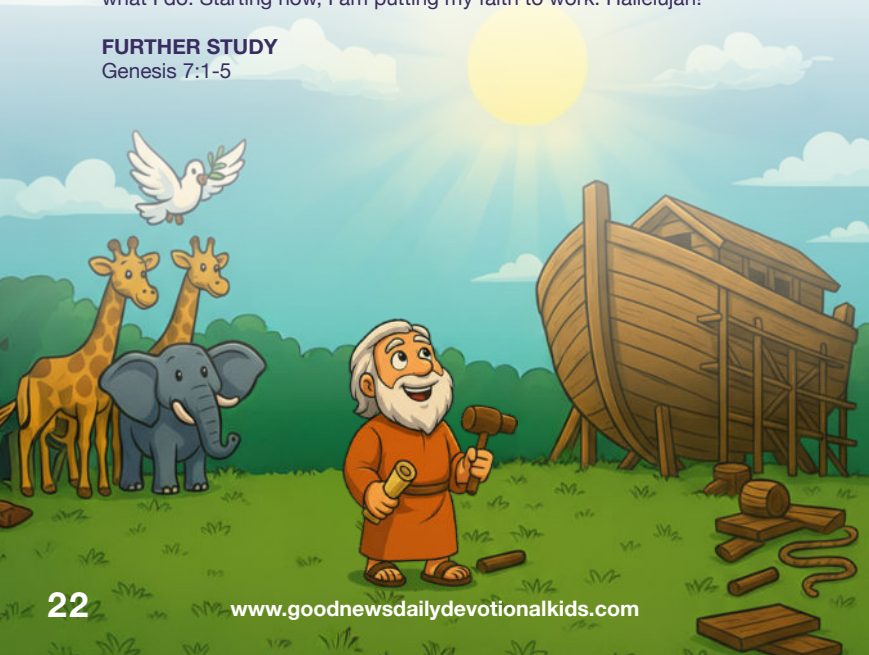
Dear God, thank You for the lessons from Noah. As your child, I choose to walk by faith and not by sight. My actions show my faith. Amen.

PRAYER FOR YOU

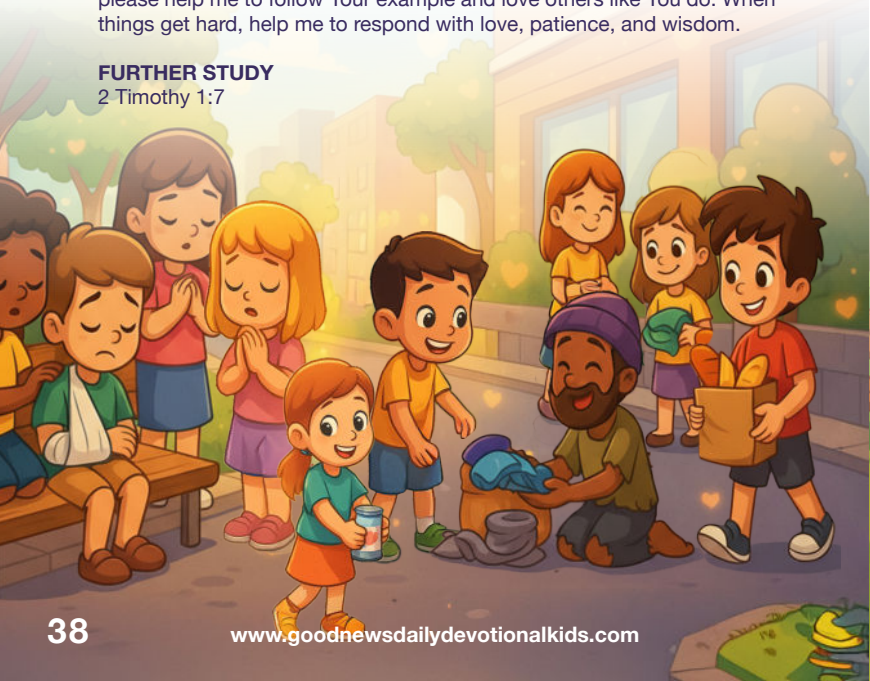

In the story of Gideon, the enemies had attacked his hometown and whilst others went to fight, he remained behind doing chores, too afraid to lift a sword. He didn't think he had it in him nor did he think he was important. But when God was looking for someone to lead the army, He didn't look for those who were strong in the battlefield. He followed Gideon and called him a "mighty warrior!" God saw something in Gideon that Gideon didn't see in himself.

I want you to know that God wants the very best for you. You may feel small, shy or not brave at all but God is telling you today, "You are strong, and I am with you". That's where true courage comes from, not from us, but from knowing God is by our side. That's all Gideon needed to hear to walk boldly and lead the army.

PRAYER FOR YOU

Dear God, thank You for seeing the best in me. Just like Gideon, I am a mighty warrior and I am as bold as a lion. Hallelujah. Amen.

PRAYER FOR YOU

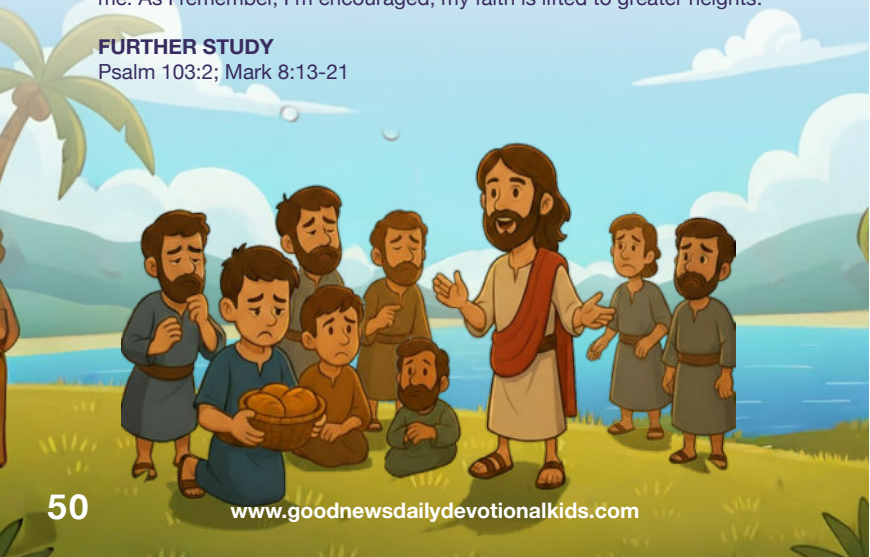

PRAYER FOR YOU

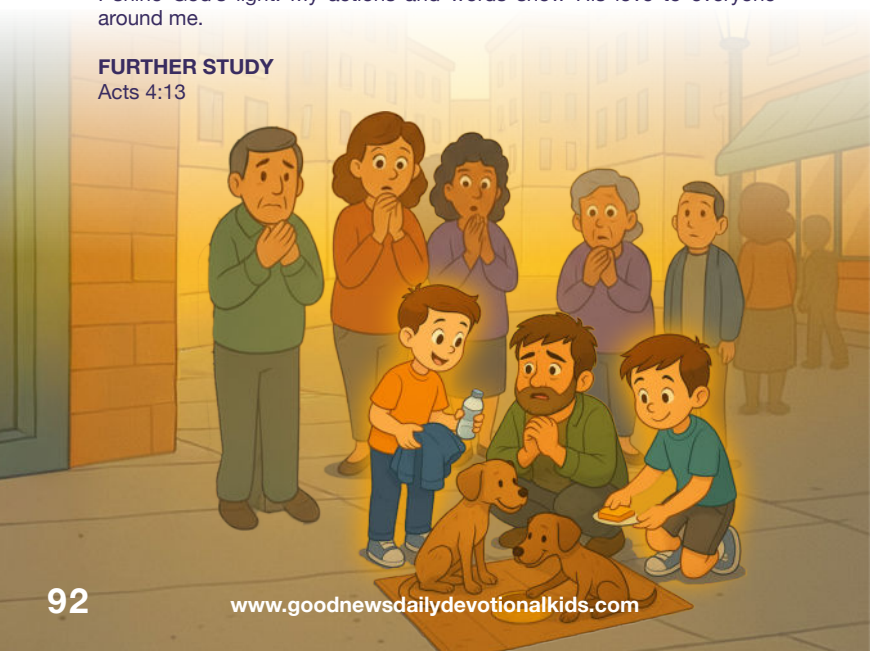
